

Pasture and Soil Fertility Workshops

Commencing October 2016 – Upper Murrumbidgee Region

Producers, land owners and managers and invited to join us for a 3 session workshop that could provide participants with the information to help them make an informed decision about managing their paddocks for improved soil and pasture health.

Sessions will cover:

- Soil Tests Soil testing your paddocks. What do your soil tests mean? What can you do to improve your soil fertility?
- Pasture Health What's growing in your paddock? Pasture & weed composition, options for pasture improvement and weed control options.
- Making Decisions based on your soil test results and paddock assessments, what plans can you make for your paddocks?





Participants will have the opportunity to undertake **2 free soil tests** on their own property during September. Additional soil tests will be available on a by one get one free basis.

Session Two – Understanding your soil tests	Monday 31 st October 2016
